Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Home Affairs Hon. Mr. Narayan Kaji Shrestha attended a reception organized by the Consulate General of Nepal, Chengdu this evening. Addressing the function, the Deputy Prime Minister stressed that every Nepali citizen should be proud of being a Nepali due to its glorious history, unique identity, rich natural endowments, and rich cultures and heritage. While highlighting the major features of Nepal-China relations including mutual respect and support for sovereignty, territorial integrity and National independence, non-interference in internal affairs, China's continued support for Nepal's development endeavours, and supporting each other in international arena, he expressed his confidence that Nepal-China relations will be wider and deeper in the interests of the two countries and peoples in the days ahead.

Stating the positive contribution made by the Nepali diaspora in the overall development of the country, he called upon students, businesspersons and others attending the event to play constructive roles to promote Nepal's positive image abroad from their respective fields.

During the event Hon. Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Home Affairs, also unveiled the "Lumbini Nepal" book in Chinese Language. This book was originally published in English by Lumbini Development Trust in 2019, which was translated and printed by this Consulate recently.

In the program, Consul General Mr. Dinesh Kumar Ghimire delivered a welcome speech in honor of the visiting Nepali delegation and briefed about the major achievements and engagements made by the Consulate General since its establishment.

The program was attended by Nepali communities including students, businesspersons, and professionals, as well as Chinese friends and well-wishers.

In the morning, the Nepali delegation led by Deputy Prime Minister Mr. Shrestha visited the 2008 Sichuan's devastating earthquake site, laid wreath on the earthquake victim's memorial and visited the earthquake museum constructed at Wenchuan County of the Aba Prefecture.

In the afternoon the delegation visited to Zipingpu Hydropower Station and Dujiangyan Irrigation system.

The Deputy Prime Minister interacted with Chinese Media on different topics including disaster cooperation, cooperation under Belt and Road Initiatives, prospects of Nepal-China relations and tourism cooperation between two countries, among others.

The Nepali delegation led by Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Home Affairs is scheduled to return to Nepal tomorrow morning.
